Virginia Judiciary Electronic Filing System (VJEFS)



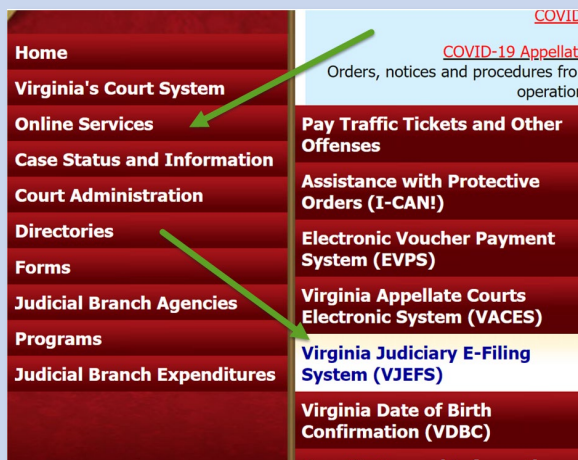
VJEFS allows the electronic filing of most civil cases in the circuit court and is for use by members of the Virginia State Bar and their designated staff.

This system also:

- Tracks Case Submissions
- Sends Status Updates and Other Notifications by Email
- Displays Case File Images Online
- Calculates Fees
- Accepts Payments Online Upon Case Filing Only

Only one completed registration application is required to be submitted and accepted by any individual circuit court clerk's office to file cases in all participating circuit courts.

Applications can be completed on Virginia's Judicial System website www.vacourts.gov by clicking on "Online Services" and Virginia Judiciary E-Filing System. There you will find links for the application and login.
